FACTS

- A diverse coalition of individuals, faith communities, human rights advocates, and grassroots organizers who have joined together to work for justice along the U.S. - Mexico Border.
- Mobilized in response to the escalating numbers of migrant deaths in the deserts of the American Southwest. Since 1998, over 2,000 men, women, and children have lost their lives attempting to cross the Border.
- A bi-national network of migrant-friendly organizations and individuals throughout the United States and northern Mexico that participate through symbolic and direct action.
- A strategy to intervene and put a stop to migrant deaths in the Borderlands.
- An action plan that includes movable desert camps, support of migrant aid centers, maintaining desert water stations, Samaritan patrols that search the desert for migrants in need, and advocacy on behalf of migrant/human rights-related issues.
- A volunteer-driven movement that encourages people from all over the country to come to southern Arizona in Summer 2004 to join the efforts to stop the loss of life in the desert.
- A non-profit organization in need of all kinds of support: financial, material, and spiritual.
