



Since 1998, more than 2,000 men, women, and children have lost their lives trying to cross the U.S.-Mexico border. The reasons for this phenomenon are varied and complex and many differences of opinion exist on the subject. But, there can be no disagreement that the status quo is unacceptable. That is why diverse communities of conscience and faith along the border have come together to demand that this horrific loss of life stop, to demand that there be **No More Deaths**.

Who Are We?

We are a group of individuals, faith communities, human rights advocates, and grassroots organizers who have come together to work for social justice in the Borderlands. Members participate in various working groups, including

- Humanitarian Assistance
- Research and Strategic Action
- National Networking
- Legislative Response
- Education & Training

We meet weekly in Tucson, Arizona at Southside Presbyterian Church. We are creating a strong bi-national movement and invite individuals and groups to join us through both symbolic and direct action.

No More Deaths endorses these **Faith-Based Principles for Immigration Reform:**

- Recognize that the current Militarized Border Enforcement Policy is a failure
- Address the status of undocumented persons currently living in the U.S.
- Make family unity and reunification the cornerstone of the U.S. immigration system
- Allow workers and their families to enter the U.S. to live and work in a safe, legal, orderly, and humane manner through an Employment-Focused immigration program
- Recognize that root causes of migration lie in environmental, economic, and trade inequities

Where Do I Begin?

- **Create a migrant center** or volunteer with a migrant center in your community. Migrant centers in the No More Deaths network commit to:
 1. Find migrants who arrive at their door a place to stay.
 2. Feed migrants
 3. Help migrants communicate with their families.

4. Help provide medical care.
5. Help provide legal counsel.
6. Provide services free of charge (there may be fees for legal or medical services).
7. Build awareness of migrant issues and concerns in your area.

- **Donate or raise money** for No More Deaths. Feeding migrants, staffing desert camps, and getting Samaritans out into the desert to provide aid to migrants requires financial assistance. Any amount of money you can raise or donate helps! Checks should be made payable to **Southside Presbyterian Church** with a “No More Deaths” note in the memo line (address on back).
